

Our Guest Speaker: Dr Allan Meyer



Allan was called to become the first Youth Pastor of Life Ministry Centre in 1978.

Later he was called to Mt Evelyn Church of Christ as Senior Minister in 1983, which became known as Careforce Church. He led Careforce Church in Melbourne for 26 years. Careforce Church was a national

leader amongst Australian churches in promoting restoration and pastoral care. Careforce Church also developed a world-changing ministry in India known as Christian Outreach Ministry.

During their ministry, Allan, and his wife Helen, co-founded Careforce Lifekeys – devoted to creating resources for leadership development, discipleship, church health, pastoral care and evangelism. Their passion is encouraging churches to embrace their calling as healing and restoring communities. Lifekeys courses have been translated into many languages.

Allan now devotes himself full time to coaching and encouraging churches to function as restoring communities.

His doctorate with Denver Seminary involved the creation of the *Valiant Man Program* – focused on fortifying and restoring the moral and spiritual integrity of men. Allan regularly addresses audiences on the big issues facing men today. Over 100,000 men have engaged with the Valiant Man program in Australia and NZ. Untold numbers around the world.

He regularly conducts a Masters Class focussed on The Church as a Restoring Community, extending the insights of the Lifekeys ministry. Allan holds a degree in Economics and Politics, a Diploma in Education and a Doctor of Ministry degree.

Allan is part of the preaching team at Stairway Church in Melbourne.

Allan met his wife Helen in high school and have been married 50 years. They have 4 children & 11 grandchildren.

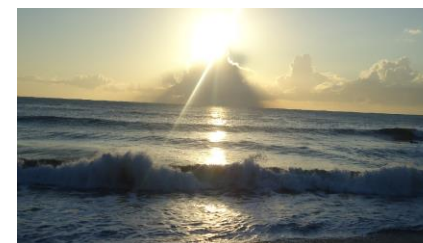
About the Collaroy Conference Centre

This well appointed Centre is located only 30 minutes north of the CBD within the northern



beaches of Sydney. The Centre enjoys stunning views of the ocean and headlands whilst situated on an elevated, peaceful bush setting. The Collaroy Centre offers modern facilities as well as access to a range of recreational facilities including a tennis and basketball court. And it's just a 5-10 minute walk to the beach where you can enjoy swimming, walking or just relaxing.

There is wheelchair and disability access to all areas of the Centre, as well as access to the downstairs bedrooms. There is a bush walking track and walking paths around the centre itself.



Within walking distance is an IGA supermarket, chemist, newsagents, old time cinema, various cafés, Surf shop, and plenty of beach.

The Centre has free WiFi, drink and snack vending machines, and great views of the ocean from the dining room balcony.

All meals (including morning and afternoon teas) will be provided and the Centre will even do our dishes for us.

We will have access to our own meeting room in which you can talk, play cards and do jigsaw puzzles.

The Hotel style rooms are spacious with contemporary styling. Each room has 2 king single beds, an en-suite, fresh towels every 2 days and fresh linen every 4 days. Also provided are an LCD TV, Aircon, Hair Dryer, Fridge, Iron & Board, and Tea & Coffee facilities.
