Opera House Guided Tour



The Sydney Opera House was opened in 1973 by Queen Elizabeth. *It stands by itself as one of the indisputable masterpieces of human creativity, not only in the 20th century but in the history of humankind.* If you suffer from severe mobility problems unfortunately this is not for you. The tour is informative and if you are a Sydneysider that has never been to it maybe it time for you to do that now. Part of the tour gets you to climb the outside steps of the Opera House. We suggest you not come if you are wary of the stairs. Wear comfortable walking shoes. **(Cost \$70, Conc \$55)**



Sydney Zoo



Sydney Zoo was only opened in 2019 with an aim to create amazing experiences for the local and international community by introducing them to a range of animal species from all over the world, while also educating on animal welfare and conservation. A world class zoo that is set to be one of Western Sydney's main attractions. Easy walking access, seating and tables to sit at, large dining area and plenty of water, food and drink stations around the zoo, *There are lions, tigers, camels, elephants, meerkats, chimpanzees, snakes, emus, kangaroos, crocodiles, cheetahs, and much, much more.* it will provide an experience that is more immersive and engaging than



traditional zoos. The grounds are flat making it easy to get around. There are mobility scooters and wheelchairs for hire if you prefer that mode of transport. **(Cost \$75, Conc \$55, wheelchair \$50 to hire with complete refund & mobility scooters \$100 with \$80 refunded)**

Historic Parramatta Guided Tour



Explore one of Australia's oldest buildings, part of a World Heritage listed site. You can see Elizabeth Farm, Hambledon Cottage, Parramatta Park, Government House, Our guided tour at the Dairy Precinct in Parramatta Park to delve into the site's fascinating stories and uncover its historical, social and architectural importance to Australia. The Dairy Cottage, built in 1796 now included on the World Heritage list. In the early 1800s, the cottage was enlarged and converted to a dairy, and a sunken milk-processing room



was constructed. There will be walking tours and there are also uneven surfaces inside the cottages and surrounding gardens, with paths and entries that may cause trips, slips or falls. Of course some of these tours may be altered depending on construction of the Parramatta Light Rail. **(Cost \$75, Conc \$70)**

National Park Tour



Sydney's heritage-listed Royal National Park is affectionately known to locals as the 'Nasho' or just 'the Royal'. Established in 1879, it's the world's second-oldest national park. It features unique heritage attractions, along with fascinating plants, birds and animals. The diverse park offers everything from beaches to rainforest. The 16,000ha Royal National Park is like a big beautiful backyard. Solo will be leaving the campsite after breakfast and heading towards Audley for morning tea/walk/lunch. Then a swim at



Bundeena then some more little walks before heading towards afternoon tea then back to the campsite **(Cost \$75, Conc \$65)**

Cruise & Dancing on Sydney Harbour
