OPTIONAL TOURS INFORMATION

(All costs include transport to & from the tour, and includes a lunch for all of the tours. Concession prices apply to all gov't pension cards, healthcare card, and unemployed.)

Mansfield Zoo Tour - Mansfield Zoo is one of North East Victoria's hidden secrets, with a large collection of exotic and native animals on 30 acres of picturesque parkland featuring lovely views across the Delatite Valley to Mt Buller. Around lunch time there is the Lion feeding that we can check out as a part of the day. The picnic areas are all undercover so a great place to have lunch. You can purchase bags of feed for the animals that you can hand feed around the zoo. Cost incl zoo entrance. **(Cost \$75, Conc/Seniors \$70)**



Lake Mountain– Lake Mountain Alpine Resort is one of Victoria's officially designated alpine resort and is operated by Alpine Resorts Victoria. Once the snow melts, our little mountain starts to turn into a burst of colour with the wildflowers starting to bloom. They offer guided Wildflower walks from November through to January. The most recent addition is the recently completed single track mountain bike trail. BBQ facilities there will allow us to have lunch as part of the tour cost **(Cost \$55)**.



Puffing Billy- Setting out from Belgrave, Puffing Billy passes the southern reaches of the beautiful Sherbrooke, a form of eucalypt and the tallest flowering plant in the world. Within minutes you will travel over Puffing Billy's most famous landmark -the iconic *Trestle Bridge*. Experience the time-honoured tradition of sitting on the carriage sill, a true thrill for young and old! Travel through the magnificent Dandenong Ranges. The train will take an hour there and an hour back, with a couple of hours at our destination. **(Cost \$95, Conc. \$85)**



Healesville Sanctuary - Discover the different trails of the Sanctuary and where to find your favourite animals. You can visit the Dingo Country or walk the Woodlands and Wetlands tracks and don't forget the old favourite of everyone...the Kangaroos! From there you can get to the Koala Country and then onto the Echidnas as well! So cuddly and so deadly all at once. There are so many, many more animals to see and look at that you will be needing time we are there to check them out. **(Cost \$85, Seniors \$80, Conc \$70)**



Regional Country Town – As a part of the tour and as time allows, we will be stopping at The Big Tree / Cora Lynn Falls, then along famous Reefton Spur stopping at the Redwood Forest (planted in the 1930's) near Warburton. There are a number of places we can go during this tour but that will be determined by the prevailing weather on the day, before returning home to El Kanah via Healesville and the equally famous Black Spur. We'll have a great time! **Cost \$75, Conc \$65)**



The Last Night's BBQ Dinner and Dancing – El Kanah have indicated that for the last night's special dinner they are going to put the tables around the outside of the dining room and open the space in the middle to dance in. Therefore we will eat and dance at the same area on the wooden dining room floor! I think this year we are going to have a BBQ on site with lots of other wonderful things once we get closer to the time.
